## COMPETITION 5/19/2012

**Purpose:** to celebrate the Classical music, and to provide students with an opportunity to perform and receive an evaluation of their performance by well-respected judge.

**Adjudicator:** **Nina Flyer-** Associate Professor of Cello at University of the Pacific and California State University, **John Cozza-** Professor of piano, accompanying and chamber music at Universities of Stockton and Sacramento.

**Date of event:** **May 19, 2012. Starts at 10 AM**

**Eligibility:** students of any age, level, and instrument are eligible to enter.

**Repertoire:** one standard repertoire composition written for solo instrument or one composition written for chamber ensemble (no method books, arrangements, pop, etc.). **All music must be memorized, except chamber music.** Students must bring music with numbered measures.

**Entry fee:** \$25 per student from Young Talents Music School and \$30 per student from the other studios. Write check or money order payable to Young Talents Music School.

All entries must be postmarked before or on **April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2012. Please send bottom part of the application and the fee to: Young Talents Music School, 4236 Winding Way, Sacramento, CA 95841.**

**Location of the Competition:** Capital Christian Center, 9470 Micron Ave, Sacramento, CA 95827 (travel HIGHWAY 50 EAST, exit right on BRADSHAW Road, right on MICRON Ave).

**Dress Code:** gentlemen- dress slacks, dress shirt, ties; ladies- long or short dressy dress. Dress shoes are required. Bow before and after performing.

**Videotaping-Photo Taking-Tape Recording** Parents can make photos or video recording of their child only.

**Accompanist:** If you don't have accompanist, school will provide one for you for \$50 (45 minutes rehearsal and performance)

**Procedure:** there will be four recitals: **Division I ages 8 and younger; Division II ages 9-11**

**Division III ages 12-14; Division IV ages 15-above**

At the end of each recital performers will be given medals and awards based upon judges' ratings. The judges' ratings are final. Students who received 1<sup>st</sup> place can not participate in the next year YTMS Competition, but can compete again in 2014. All recitals are open for public and held in nice, friendly, and supporting atmosphere.
